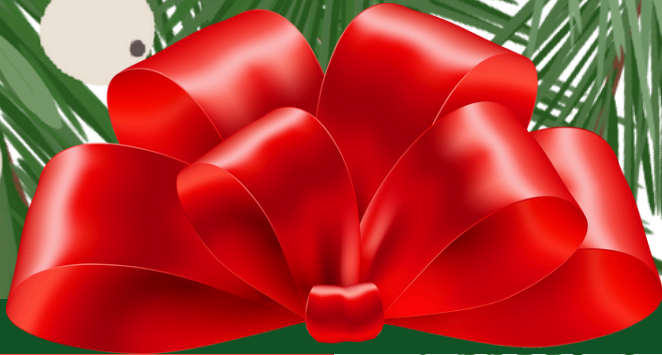




DECEMBER KINDNESS CHALLENGES
